Amongst his publications are a number that deal directly with the celebration of the Mass, including *Why the Mass Matters* (St Pauls), *Eucharist and Justice* (Australian Catholic Social Justice Council), *Understanding the General Instruction of the Roman Missal* (St Pauls), *Lord Hear Our Prayer: Praying the General Intercessions* (St Pauls), and *Earth Unites with Heaven: an introduction to the Liturgical Year* (Morning Star).

- Offer some historical background to the liturgy
- Take you into current practice
- Reveal the pastoral sensitivities in our celebration
- Open up the way the Mass is arrayed to transform us and renew us.
